## Author's Vision Suggests New Limits of Knowledge A spiritual destiny awakens humankind from its blindness to ancient truths

UDINE, Italy - Destiny. Knowledge. Truth.

Conventional wisdom may not provide complete, or even accurate, interpretations of these universally pondered concepts, but Francesco Alessandrini urges the human mind to reconnect with a spiritual and ancient "true knowledge" which has been lost or forgotten through the passage of time.

Alessandrini's new book, Voyage in Destiny: Part Four (published by AuthorHouse), looks to recapture ancient truths and reconnect humanity with a spiritual understanding of destiny and creation.

Generally we do not notice destiny, but, if we are able to interpret and listen to things which happen to us, at times we can pick up signs which try to align us to it.

In the end destiny unfolds itself even if we willingly oppose it. It is better to try and follow it without creating too many obstacles on the way.

Although Voyage in Destiny is Alessandrini's work, he prefers to credit the knowledge within it to "spiritual beings with a vision that is enormously wider than ours" known as the Masters. Alessandrini sees his connection with the Masters, to whom he dedicates the book, as the inspiration which allowed him to acquire an understanding of "true knowledge," and Voyage in Destiny is his interpretation of that "wider vision."
